

DELHI PUBLIC LIBRARY LIBRARY CARD

Who Can Get A Library Card:

Library Cards are available to anyone that is a resident of Delhi and its surrounding communities.

If a person is from another town, they must be in good standing with the library of their town before we can issue them a card at our library. Meaning they must have no issues returning the books on time and have all materials returned and fines paid.

A valid ID must be presented at time of issuance. A phone number and email will be needed also.

How to Apply for a Library Card:

Applicants must fill out an application form which can be obtained at the library.

If applicants are younger than 12, the signature of either a parent or legal guardian is required on the application and they will need to provide proof of address.
