expected to set up and take down any tables, chairs, or equipment that

is used in and for the meeting.

Likewise, any cleanup required will be the responsibility of the group

using the community room.

The community room, located at the back of the public library, offers

chairs, tables, a white board, easel, and free wi-fi. There are no facilities

available for the preparation of food, however there is a microwave

and small refrigerator located in the room.

No posters or pictures are to be mounted on the walls of the

community room without prior permission from the library.
